



House rules for ASVZ sports facilities

Access

- Everyone must show their valid student ID or ASVZ card in order to access our sports facilities. The staff is required to check all passes and refuse access to anyone without a valid card.
- Anyone who violates this rule will be charged with trespassing and fined CHF 100.

General rules

- Smoking and alcohol consumption are forbidden in the entire sports facility.
- Eating is not permitted in the sports halls.
- Damage caused to buildings or equipment must be reported to the facility management. Anyone who causes damage deliberately or through negligence will be held liable to pay compensation and will be charged with damage to property.
- Disruption, harassment and offences against public decency will not be tolerated and will lead to criminal charges.
- Any advertising, photography and video recordings on the premises must be authorized.
- Clean sports shoes must be worn for training at our sports facilities. In addition, towels must be used in the weight training halls.
- Sports bags and street clothes may not be brought into the sports halls. They must be left in the changing rooms or in the lockers. Lockers are available for a small price at the ASVZ desk and sometimes at the facility management office. Unattended bags may be removed by the facility management and can be recovered for a fee of CHF 15.
- Please arrive punctually for the start of the classes and leave the sports facility before the closing time in the evenings.
- Children are not granted access to the sports facility except during Juniors Club hours:

You must comply with all the instructions given by facility personnel or ASVZ Staff. Anyone who violates these rules may be banned from entering ASVZ sports facilities.

Medical service/emergency

- The facility management must always be informed in the case of an emergency. It can be contacted at the facility management office or by telephone (from the office) and will arrive within minutes.

Found items

- Found items must be handed in to the facility management. The ASVZ accepts no liability in case of loss or theft. We recommend keeping valuables and personal items in the lockers.
